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e-EVALINTO What?

e-EVALINTO is intended to reduce early school leaving (**objective**) in young students with migrant background (**target group**) through a prevention and early intervention strategy (**need**) based on peer mentoring actions



e-EVALINTO What?

e-EVALINTO is intended to develop an ICT framework (**objective**) for assessing, managing and developing activities for intercultural contexts (**target group**), with particular focus to taking decision processes (**need**) and identification of different patterns that may be induced from the variety of potential situations to be analysed.


