handling the affairs of students with disabilities related to their studies at the University

oversees the use of normative financial aid to support the studies of students with disabilities

monitors the proportional representation of women and men

The Committee consists of one member delegated by each of the Faculties and one student member. Its members are appointed by the Rector for one year on the proposal of the Faculties.

STUDY AND EXAMINATION REGULATIONS

disability-friendly training and examinations must be provided

Where appropriate, they should be exempted from the obligation to study certain subjects, parts of subjects or to do certain reports. If necessary, they should be exempted from the language exam requirements.

replacing the written examination with an oral one, or the oral examination with a written one



Providing a personal assistant, note-taking interpreter, sign language interpreter during the student's studies in case of a student with hearing disabilities

Accessibility of content of lectures, exercises and exams in either sound format digitally, in braille or magnification in case of a student with seeing disabilities

With hyperactivity, longer examinations can be broken up to several installments, or they can be allowed breaks or physical activity without leaving the examination room



A student with a proven disability can submit their to the Equal Opportunities Committee

Assistance to students with disabilities is provided on an institutional and faculty side by a trained and experienced equal opportunities coordinator
