It is also justified by meeting innovation challenges: the establishment of laboratories, IT and technical research centers.

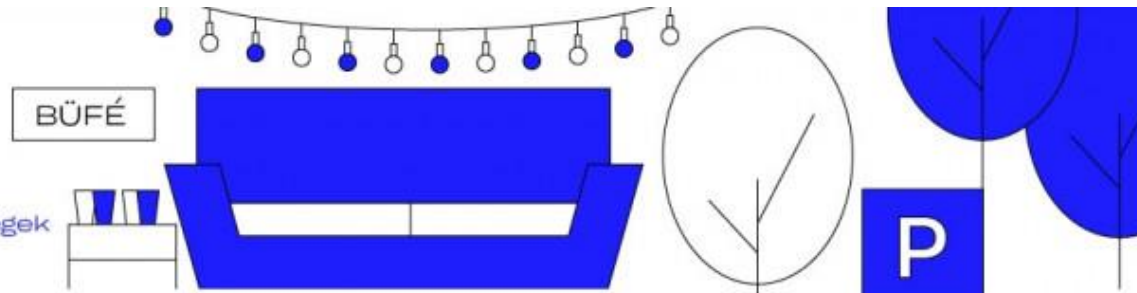


CURRENT STATUS OF THE NEW CAMPUS — WHAT DO STUDENTS WANT AND NEED?

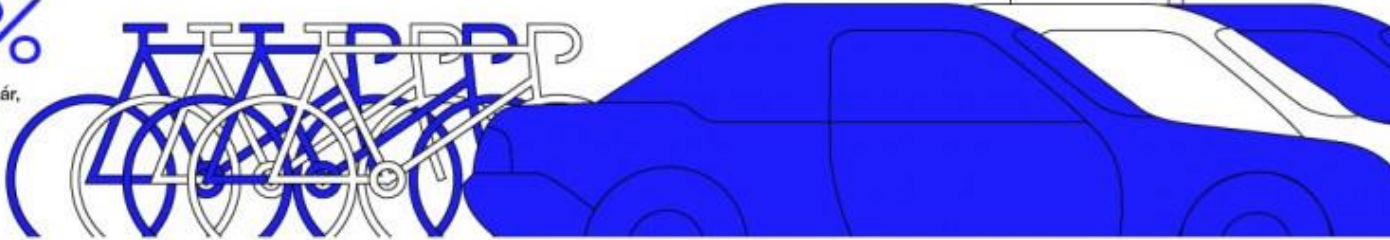

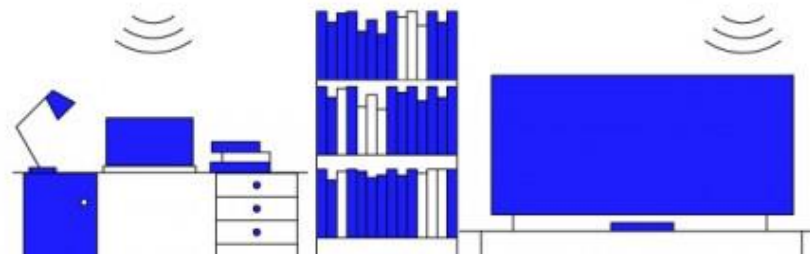
