MASTER'S DEGREE IN MANAGEMENT AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

- The teaching is face-to-face
- The duration of the master's degree is one year
- Around 40 external professionals teach on the master's degree course.
- Lecturers from the French University of Brest teach under SEA-EU programme.
- We would be interested in incorporating teachers and students from the French-speaking world (*francophonie*).
- Existence of the Institute for Social and Sustainable Development (INDESS) for research.
- Half of the students are foreigners, mainly from Latin America.
- Possibility of internships in local, regional and national institutions and public administrations.
- Faculty involved in innovation processes



MASTER'S DEGREE IN MANAGEMENT AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

- The tuition fee is 880 euros payable in instalments.
- Scholarships are available for a 3-month Final Master 's Thesis (TFM) at Latin American universities.
- Possibility of receiving a prize for the best TFM from the city of Jerez and the university.
- Sports facilities: swimming pool, paddle,...
- Pre-registration in January, June and September.
- Special concern for the student's labour market insertion
- Existence of an alumni association
- High level of student satisfaction with the master
