



HISTORY OF THE INSTITUTE



TARGETED PROGRAM OF CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF FACILITIES, IMPLEMENTED AT THE EXPENSE OF EXTRA-BUDGETARY FUNDS
