

- Trade unionism and social movements.
- Gender inequalities.
- Public policies.
- Political elites and representation from a feminist perspective.
- Foreign policy and international relations.
- Migratory movements.





Researching sociology (II)







Translation: Social changes and conflicts in contemporary societies

Main areas of research are:

- -Well-being, care and social intervention.
- -Democracy, participation and social movement.
- -Heritage, culture and new consumption patterns.
- -Socio-spatial relations, new rurality and conflict.
- -Work, (im)mobilities and gender.





INTERNATIONAL NETWORK RESEARCH





Translation: Ibero-American Research Network on Work, Gender and Everyday Life

Main areas of research are:

- Work, labor and employment.
- Reconciliation and co-responsibility of work, family and personal life.
- Gender inequalities in employment and time use.
- Gender-based violence.
- Gender pay gap.
- -Gender equality policies.





Opportunities, challenges, new research questions from a sociological perspective

- How to Integrate sociology into the curricula of a greater number of undergraduate and postgraduate degrees.
- 2) How to increase the participation of sociology in interdisciplinary teams that address lines and interests of research with multi-causal and multi-level explanations.
- 3) How to include **gender and intersectional perspective** in the analysis of the universities, in terms of teaching, research and management.





Forthcoming International Research Projects

- 1) Feminist urbanism: introducing a gender perspective in the design and implementation of urban policies: What are governments doing to build women-friendly cities?
- 2) Resistance and counter-resistance to equality within organisations (political, educational and judiciary institutions).
- 3) Advances and setbacks in equality as a consequence of the rise of populist radical right parties in contemporary societies. (PRRPs)
