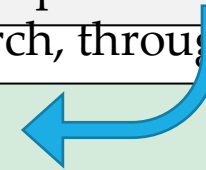

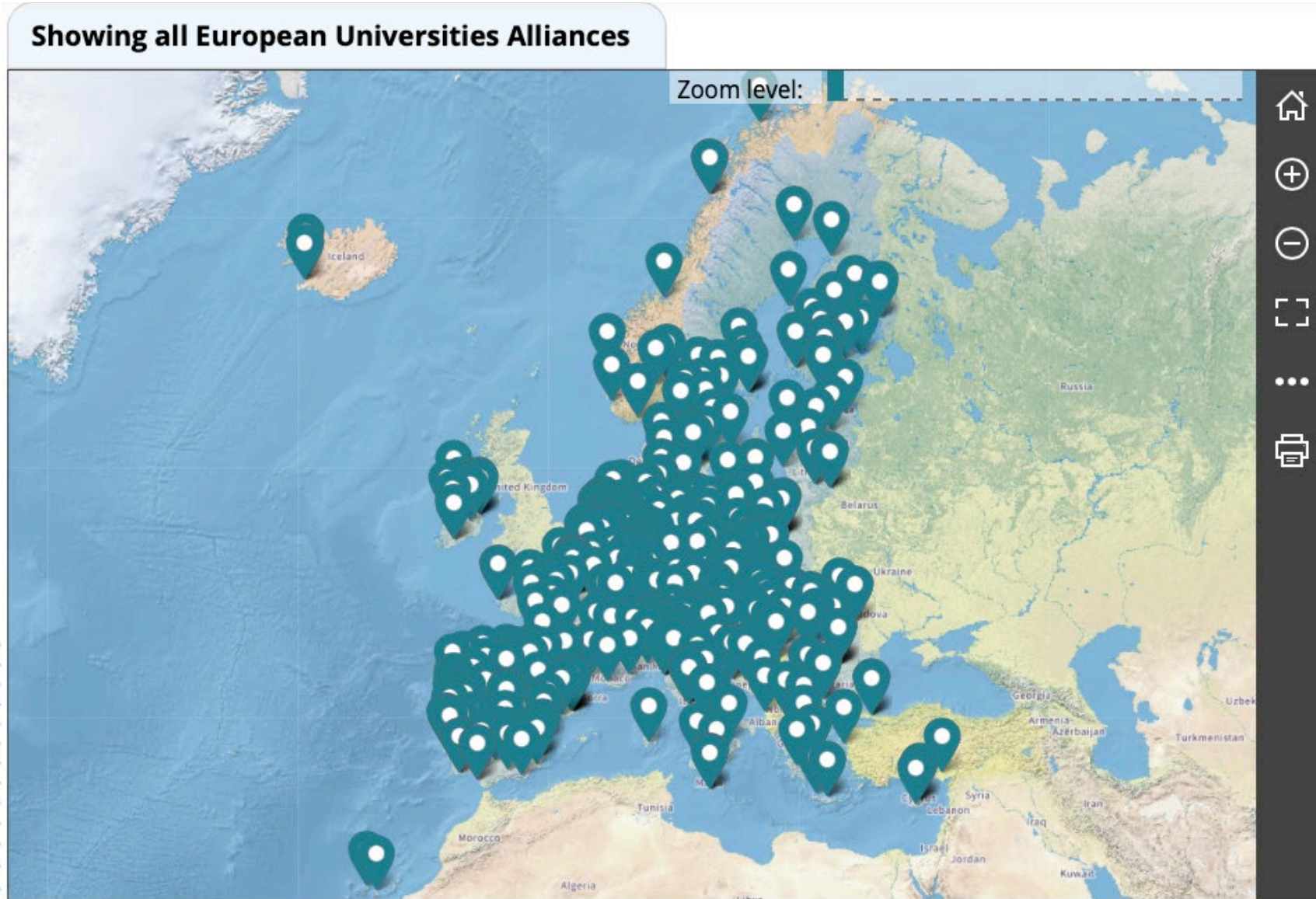

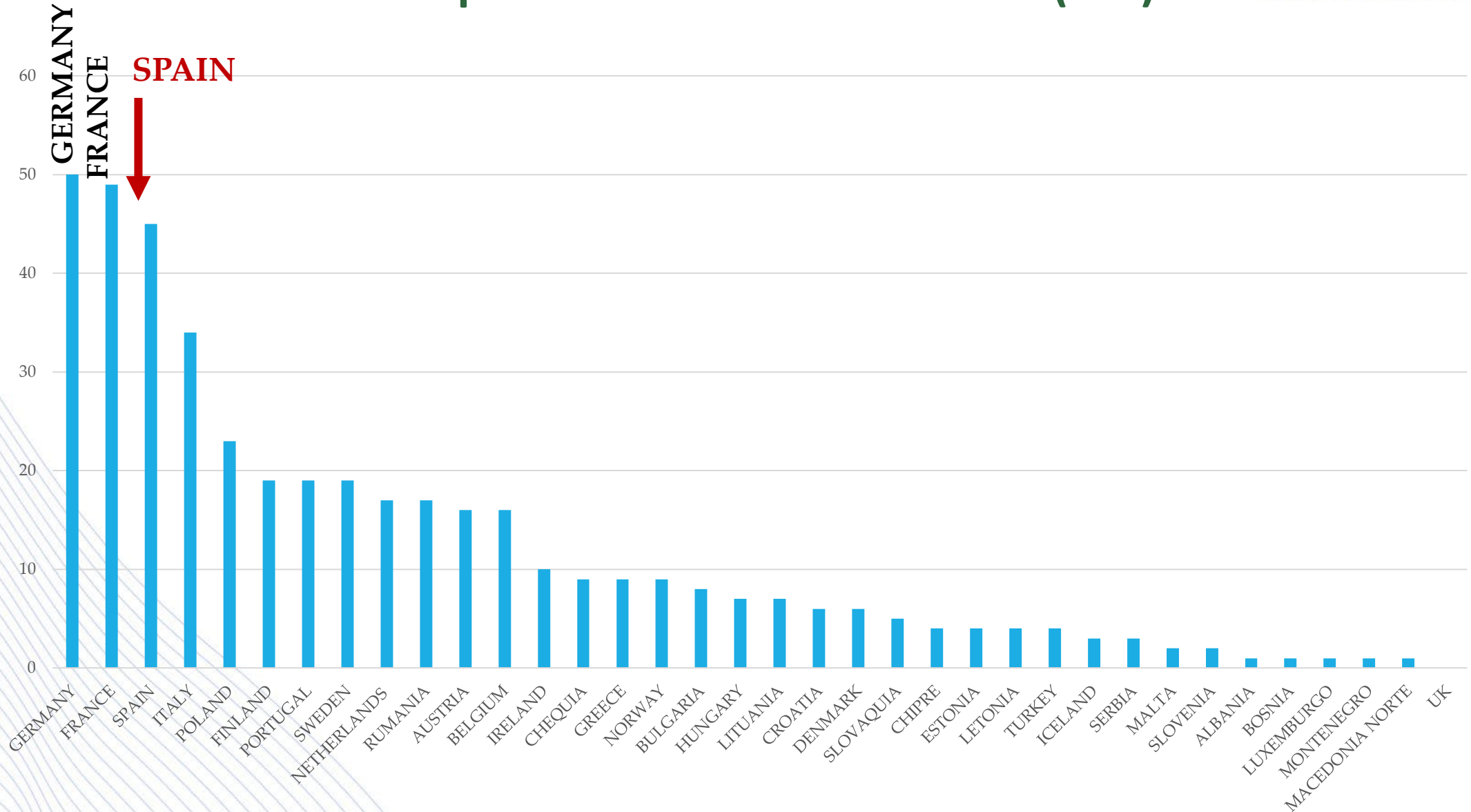

The European University of the Seas (SEA-EU)

- **Start SEA-EU: Oct. 2019 (1^a call) - Dec. 2022 [3 years]**
- **2^a phase SEA-EU 2.0: Jan. 2023- Dec. 2026 [4 years]**
- SEA-EU includes **9 (formerly 6) universities located in coastal cities** with a tradition of economic, cultural, historical, sport activities related to the sea.
- Marine and maritime issues are important in our Universities, but the **alliance aims to link all 9 Universities with all their capacities, not only marine.**
- **Covers all the European marine basins** within its geographical scope. (Baltic / Atlantic /

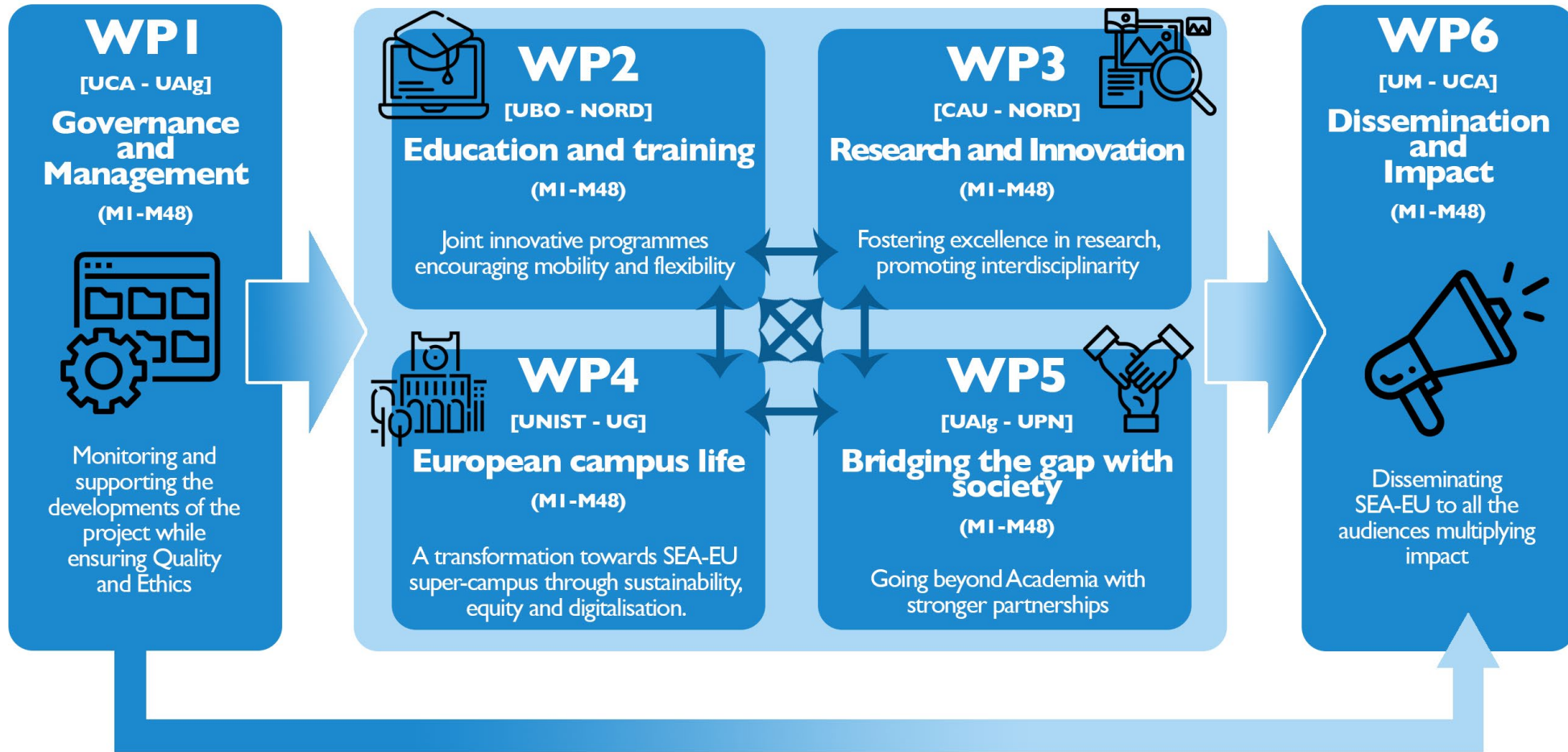
