UCv is based in the city of Craiova, in the historical region of Oltenia, in the South-West of Romania, bordered by the Danube river and the Sub-Carpathians.




Academic offer:

UCv has a comprehensive structure, consisting of 12 faculties:




Study programmes in foreign languages (LMD):
