In order to establish a solid foundation for discussion, the meeting aims to stimulate a broader reflection on definitions and methodological approaches, proceeding with the identification of the common research areas for collaboration of the researchers in OSBE. The participants are invited to present their existing research on the blue economy, while a specific section is dedicated for the human resource management in the blue economy. The first set of activities serves to establish a common ground for the second set of activities which are dedicated to the projection of the topics for common research projects and papers. The emphasis is on defining and delineating the roles of stakeholders within OSBE. The meeting wraps up with reflections on the OSBE webpage and the planning of upcoming activities.
