Please read carefully the following useful information for our Erasmus incoming students:



The teaching period at University of Cadiz is organized **yearly**. **Courses** are taught during the following period (Exam session included):

- **Annual modules:** 23rd September 2024 – 25th June 2025.
- **Subjects' 2nd Semestre:** 10th February 2025 – 25th June 2025.

VERY IMPORTANT: the dates on your acceptance letter are provisional. The official dates of the semestre are the ones mentioned above.

Those are the official dates for the semestre. **MÁSTER** students **attending ONLY Master's modules** will have to contact their coordinators to confirm the beginning of the classes.

Student's **staying a single semestre** can only attend the courses offered in such semestre. They cannot attend courses offered in other semesters nor full-year courses.

IMPORTANT

Your **ID number** at the University of Cádiz provided in your acceptance letter coincides with your Passport or ID Card number. We kindly ask you to use the **same number when enrolling** in the language courses.

IMPORTANT

We recommend **students studying at the Jerez and Algeciras** campuses to find accommodation in these cities. Jerez is 30 Km away and Algeciras 120 km away from Cádiz.

Special information for **students studying at Puerto Real Campus**: Cádiz and Puerto Real is close campuses. Students may choose Cádiz or Puerto Real to live.

Spanish language courses

The Official Beginning of the Academic year is **10th February** but please have a look at the information about the Spanish courses offered by the Centre of Modern Languages (CSLM): intensive courses starting at the beginning of each semestre, before classes start (approx. **7th January 2025**) and 3-month regular courses during each of the semesters. The Internationalisation Office at the University of Cadiz partially finances one of these Spanish language courses.

To be able to *register in the University of Cádiz as an Exchange student* you need to have a **mandatory** insurance that covers, at least, the following conditions:

1. **European Health Insurance** (for students of the European Union**).
2. **Additional insurance** which contains the following (mandatory for all students, including those with European Health): **a)** Repatriation; **b)** Accident insurance; **c)** Liability insurance and **d)** Health.

The **University of Cádiz recommends the following insurance**, but you can contract a different one, as long as it covers, at least, the above-mentioned insurances: Ergo Insurance.

****NOTE** for **European Union citizen students**: the European Health Insurance card is NOT enough. You will also need to have an insurance that covers point 2 requisites. Additionally, please do not forget the European Health Insurance Card.

IMPORTANT —

Cádiz, Jerez y Puerto Real are well connected by public transport. Therefore, they are multiple possibilities to get to Cádiz, Jerez and Puerto Real. You can *rent a car* at the airport and drive to Cádiz or take the *shuttle bus* from the airport to Seville Train Station (Santa Justa) or Seville, Prado de San Sebastian bus station. From there, you can take the *bus or train* to Cádiz, Puerto Real or Jerez.

How to get to Cádiz from...

- **Jerez de la Frontera and Sevilla:** they are the closest airports located 30 kms away and Sevilla Airport (SVQ) which although further away (130 kms), is also easily reached from Cadiz by train ([click here](#)) or bus. From Sevilla there are flights to many European destinations.
