













Interested in an international learning experience and exchange? Then apply for participation in the Blended Intensive Program (BIP) 'Evidence-based practice and complex interventions in neurological rehabilitation'

This BIP is an elective master course (5 ECTS) delivered by experts in motor rehabilitation from KU Leuven (Belgium, 2026 course coordinator), Nord University (Norway), University of Cadiz (Spain) and Aarhus University (Denmark).

When selected, you will join the course in Spring 2026. Course elements are:

- 1. Online teaching module on 11 and 12 February 2026 (2-6pm) covering course introduction, educational systems, health systems and neurorehabilitation in the participating countries and evidence-based practice & guidelines.
- 2. Physical teaching module from 16 to 20 March 2026 in Leuven, Belgium providing a teaching and cultural program. The teaching includes lectures by the BIP faculty on selected complex interventions in neurorehabilitation (covering theoretical basis and evidence base, practical sessions and clinical reasoning). Group work, discussion and presentations are an integral part of the BIP.
- 3. Online evaluation by means of a group presentation on 22 April 2026 (2-6pm). Preparation starts during the physical week with dedicted time each day. The last day, your group presents the provisional presentation and receives feedback from the BIP faculty.
